Treasurer's Report

As reported at the recent AGM, it gives me great pleasure to announce a surplus for the financial year May 2011 - April 2012 of £1161 which, considering some of the costs we have incurred during the year, is quite an exceptional result. Both Show Stoppers (2011) and Oliver! generated a healthy surplus which offset some of the high, but expected, staging costs for Beauty & the Beast. Our general costs for the year had increased on the previous year, particularly relating to running costs for the studio; however our fund raising efforts were superb allowing us to generate an overall surplus. There are many people who have contributed to the financial success of the society throughout the year but I would particularly like to thank Debbie Bowyer and Mike Byrne for their organisation of the Auction of Promises which raised an incredible £1300.

As a member of the Committee and with my Treasurer hat on, I am delighted to be part of a society that can entertain local audiences with exceptionally high quality performances, and still remain financially sound. Many thanks to everyone involved during the year!

Chairman's message

Well, here we are at the start of another year with the new committee primed and raring to go!

Jubilee Show Stoppers was a great success with both evening performances being sold out and an audience of 80+ for the matinee. We went with a traditional cream tea for the afternoon and a "posh" ploughman's followed by Apple Pie and Cream for the evening. Thank you so much to everyone who helped with putting out food, in particular Amanda McCluskey, Jane Clayton and Mark Waters who all came along on both nights and the entire Foster family who all stayed until the bitter end helping with the clearing up on the Friday night. I hope the chickens enjoyed their own version of the posh ploughmans!

The show itself went down very well (whether that was aided by the excellent bar takings we shall never know!) and thanks must go to everyone involved – the cast, wardrobe, musicians William Godfree, Allie Duguid and Leo Hilson, Jennie Budden for organizing FoH and everyone who helped waitressing or on the bar. No doubt Sally will have mentioned it in her report but I was delighted by the result of around £1,500 surplus.

Onwards and upwards.....up a mountain actually.....and we're in to **Sound of Music**. We had some exceptionally good auditions from the children on the morning of Sunday 17 June and I know the audition panel was just sorry that any of them had to be turned away. Along with the adults we have ended up with a fantastic cast and auditions are already well under way. We are looking for parents to support the production by taking it in turns to stay to the children's rehearsals so if you are asked please do be prepared to help out. We will also need matrons for the week of the show although this should be a much more straightforward task than Oliver!!

The AGM was held on Tuesday 19 June where we had a few changes to the committee. Lisa Bailey and Jane McMichael stepped down from the committee and Arabella (Arry) Biddle was voted on. Since then we have persuaded Jane to continue so she has been co-opted back on.

One of the issues raised at the AGM was that of patron subscriptions – how much should patrons pay and what should they get in return. Our income from patron subs has gone down quite substantially in the last couple of years so a few changes were in order. The committee has now discussed the issue of patrons and is proposing a patron subscription of £20 per

I know there's always a temptation to sit back and think "oh, somebody else will do that" but we need you! We've just had an excellent year both artistically and financially.... Show Stoppers brought something different to the traditional music hall, Beauty & The Beast set us all sorts of new and exciting challenges and Oliver! can only be described as a resounding success... thanks must go to each and every person involved. However, if we're going to continue to be successful we need each and every person to do their little bit.... however small. So please, next time you see a request for help..... just think "Hmmm.... maybe I'll give them a hand". We really look forward to hearing from you!! For now though, here's to another enjoyable and successful year.
